### **ATHLETIC PARTICIPATION POLICY**

The purpose of the athletic programs at the Gilmanton School are:

- To develop the athletic ability of all eligible students while supporting their academic development;

- To develop positive attitudes, good sportsmanship and responsibility of all participants;
- To provide students with good adult role-models and strengthen student-adult relationships;
