ADMINISTRATION IN POLICY ABSENCE

In the absence of established Board policy or Board direction, the Superintendent shall assume responsibility in making necessary decisions. In such instances, the Principal or other administrative or instructional personnel shall gain the approval of the Superintendent before taking any action.

In the situations which arise within the School where the Board has provided no guidelines for administrative action, the Superintendent shall have power to act but his/her decisions shall be subject to review and ratification by action of the Board at a regular meeting. It shall be the duty of the Superintendent to inform the Board promptly of such action and of the need for policy.
