

1 **GILMANTON SCHOOL BOARD MEETING**

2 **TUESDAY, OCTOBER 29, 2013**

3 **GILMANTON SCHOOL SCIENCE ROOM**

4 Board Members Present: Michael Hatch, Robert Carpenter and Adam Mini. Absent were Renee  
5 Kordas and Malcolm MacLeod.

6 Others Present: Superintendent John Fauci and Recording Clerk Rachel Hatch.

7 **CALL TO ORDER:**

8 Board Chair Michael Hatch called the School Board Meeting to order at 5:00 PM

9 **PROOF OF POSTING:**

10 Proof of posting was verified by Rachel Hatch.

11 **DISCUSSION ITEM:**

12 **2013 – 2014 Snow Plowing Bids**

13 The Board received seven snow plowing bids. Robert Carpenter asked if Sumner Scape's bid  
14 included salt or sand and snow removal. Superintendent Fauci stated that he happened to be in  
15 the office when Mr. Sumner dropped off the bid and spoke with him briefly. Mr. Sumner's bid  
16 did not include application of salt or sand. Chairman Hatch stated that the snow is pushed back  
17 and not removed from the school parking lot. Superintendent Fauci stated that salt is applied and  
18 not sand. Salting is on an as-needed basis. Superintendent Fauci had indicated to Mr. Sumner  
19 that the school uses salt and not sand.

20 Of the seven bids, the two lowest bids were from Sumner Scape and Clairmont Asphalt and  
21 Paving. Superintendent Fauci stated that he had completed reference checks on both of the  
22 lowest bidders and the references were very positive in nature. Superintendent Fauci stated that  
23 the shoveling is done by the janitorial staff. He stated that the school owns two snow blowers.

24 **Robert Carpenter made the motion to award the 2013-2014 snow plowing bid to Sumner  
25 Scape. The motion was seconded by Adam Mini and was unanimously approved by the  
26 three board members.**

27 **On a motion made by Adam Mini, seconded by Robert Carpenter, members of the board,  
28 by roll call vote, entered in to non-public session at 5 :08 p.m.**

29 Present in non-public session were Chairman Michael Hatch, Vice Chairperson Renee Kordas,  
30 Adam Mini, Robert Carpenter and Superintendent John Fauci.

31 **By consensus, the Board came out of non-public session at 5:35 p.m.**

32 **Renee Kordas made the motion to renew Superintendent Fauci's contract. The motion was  
33 seconded by Adam Mini. The vote was three (3) in the affirmative and one (1) abstention  
34 (Chairman Michael Hatch).**

35 Superintendent Fauci stated that he had forgotten to add two coaching nominations; namely, Paul  
36 Cammarota for 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade boys' basketball and Jacob Goodwin for 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> grade girls'  
37 basketball. He asked if the Board could take action on these two nominations at this time.

38 (Malcolm MacLeod arrived at 5:32 p.m.)

39 **Adam Mini made the motion to approve the nomination of Paul Cammarota as coach of**  
40 **the 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade boys' basketball and the nomination of Jacob Goodwin as coach of the**  
41 **5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> grade girls' basketball. The motion was seconded by Adam Mini and approved**  
42 **by four (4) in favor and one (1) abstention (Malcolm MacLeod abstained since he had just**  
43 **arrived).**

44 It was the consensus of the Board to adjourn the meeting at 5:35 p.m.
