Trust that members of the public will understand if the Board is unable to respond immediately to an inquiry because of the press of other business, the fact that the Board has not had a chance to discuss the subject of the inquiry or because the Board is unable to respond on a matter that is legally treated as confidential, such as a personnel issue.
